ArcelorMittal Tubular Products Karviná has completed its investment in the automation of steel tubes and profiles packaging. Manual packaging in Karviná has ended, replaced by a modern automated solution. The automated cycle of securing a rectangular bundle of profiles or a hexagonal bundle of tubes occurs without operator presence. The automatic packaging line can secure a six-meter bundle of profiles or tubes with steel bands in just 108 seconds.

"With the integration of the automatic packaging equipment, we have completed the final phase of the investment project for production automation in the Profilovna. Packaging automation allows us to fully utilize the capacity of rolling lines no. 7 and 10," said René Fabik, CEO of ArcelorMittal Tubular Products Karviná.
