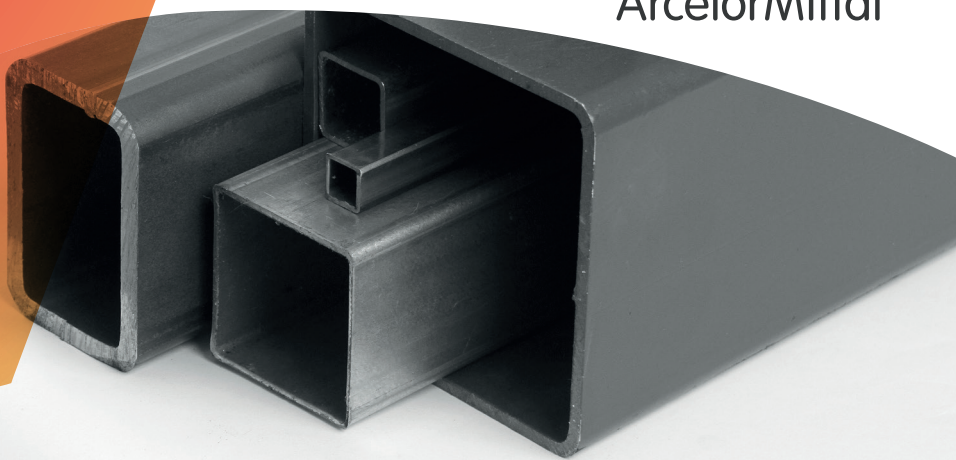

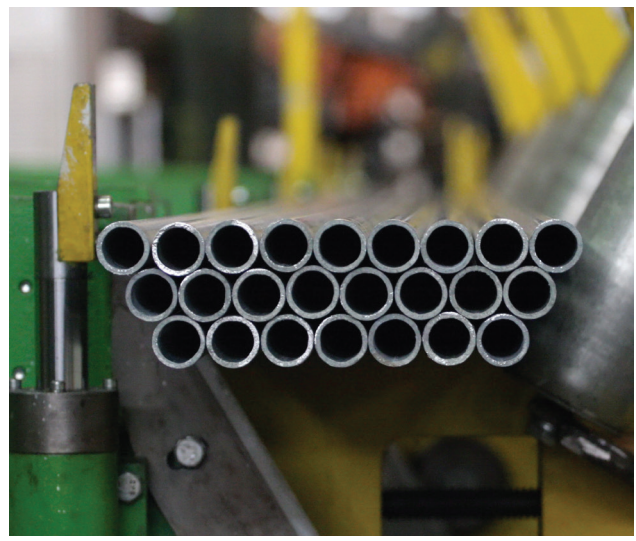

## ArcelorMittal Tubular Products Karviná increased its investments by 15%

The manufacturing company in Karviná is investing tens of millions of Czech crowns this year to improve the efficiency of production facilities, production automation, and reducing the energy consumption of buildings in the Czech Republic. ArcelorMittal Tubular Products Karviná plans to implement 15 investment projects, representing a 15% increase in investments compared to last year. The projects will, for example, focus on the automation of packaging in two production lines, decentralization of heating in buildings on the company's premises, reconstruction of roofs in production areas, and safety measures in the painting line. The main suppliers of investment projects are expected to be companies from the Czech Republic.



## ArcelorMittal: the goal is zero emissions by 2050

ArcelorMittal Europe Group has committed to reducing CO<sub>2</sub> emissions by 35 % by 2030, with an ambitious target of achieving zero emissions by 2050. The XCarb® brand brings together ArcelorMittal's products with reduced, low, and zero carbon content, steel

In April of this year, René Fabik, the Chairman of the Board of ArcelorMittal Tubular Products Karviná,

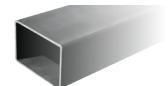
attended the traditional meeting with former employees of the Karviná unit. During the meeting, he provided updates on the current affairs within the company, among other information.
